## DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC SELECTION CRITERIA

### BMX SX Racing Elite Men and Women Junior U19 Men and Women

#### 2019 UCI BMX SX World Championships

23 – 28 July 2019, Heusden-Zolder, Belgium

#### 1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Athletes will be required to earn 2019 UCI BMX SX World Championships Team selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the Cycling Australia (CA) selection criteria.
- 1.2 Objectives: See clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.
- 1.3 Performance Time Period: 9 June 2018 - 9 June 2019
- 1.4 Team size: Refer to clause 3.3 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.

#### 2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 Subject always to the Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships, the Panel may consider athletes for selection to the BMX Freestyle World Championships team based upon performance in competitions (in section 3) and discretionary factors in clause 2 Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships.

#### 3. SELECTION EVENTS AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS (BMX SX)

- 3.1 If athletes attain a minimum of two performances in the events listed below at 3.1.1 or 3.1.2 they will automatically be eligible for consideration. If athletes do not attain such performances they may be considered for selection in accordance with clause 2.2 of the

*Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.

**3.2** The selection panel may consider the performance outcomes and standards indicated below for junior men and junior women. If athletes attain a minimum of two performances in the events listed below at 3.2.1 they will automatically be eligible for consideration. If athletes do not attain such performances they may be considered for selection in accordance with clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.

#### **4. SCHEDULE FOR 2019 UCI BMX SX WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS TEAM SELECTION**

**4.1** The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2019 UCI BMX SX World Championships are:

- Monday, 10 June 2019 (5PM AEST) – Deadline for submission of recorded performances for selection purposes
- Friday, 14 June 2019 (5PM AEST) – Final team selections forwarded to Cycling Australia CEO for review
- Tuesday, 18 June 2019 (5PM AEST) – Final team announced by CA
- Thursday, 20 June 2019 (5PM AEST) – closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, clause 7)
- Monday, 22 June 2019 – Scheduled week for appeal hearings, if required.
