DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC SELECTION CRITERIA

BMX SX Racing Elite Men and Women Junior U19 Men and Women

2020 UCI BMX SX World Championships

26 - 31 May 2020, Houston, USA

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Athletes will be required to earn 2020 UCI BMX SX World Championships Team selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the Cycling Australia (CA) selection criteria.
- 1.2 Objectives: See clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.
- 1.3 Performance Time Period: 23 July 2019 - 28 March 2020
- 1.4 Team size: Refer to clause 3.3 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1 Consideration for selection to the BMX SX World Championships Team may be based upon achieving;
 - i) Performances in Section 3 of this document, and/ or
 - ii) In accordance with clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.
- 2.2 Where more athletes meet the criteria than there are places available, selectors may use absolute discretion to rank athletes according to some or all of the factors in clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.

3. SELECTION EVENTS AND PERFORMANCE STANDARDS (BMX SX)

3.1 If athletes attain a minimum of two performances in the events listed below at 3.1.1 or 3.1.2 during the performance time period, they will automatically be eligible for consideration. If athletes do not attain such performances, they may be considered for selection in accordance with clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.

3.1.1 Men (Elite)

- 2019 UCI SX World Championships Top 8
- UCI SX World Cups Top 8
- UEC SX HC/C1 Top 5
- USA BMX SX HC/C1 Top 3
- UCI SX HC/C1 events not listed above Win

3.1.2 Women (Elite)

- 2019 UCI SX World Championships Top 6
- UCI SX World Cups Top 6
- UEC SX HC/C1 Top 4
- USA BMX SX HC/C1 Top 2
- UCI SX HC/C1 events not listed above Win

3.2 The selection panel may consider the performance outcomes and standards indicated below for junior men and junior women. If athletes attain a minimum of two performances in the events listed below at 3.2.1 during the performance time period, they will automatically be eligible for consideration. If athletes do not attain such performances, they may be considered for selection in accordance with clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.

3.2.1 Men and Women (Juniors)

- 2019 SX World Championships Top 8
- UCI SX HC/C1 Win
- 2020 SX Continental Championships Win
- 2020 SX National Championships Win

4. SCHEDULE FOR 2020 UCI BMX SX WORLD CHAMPIONSHIPS TEAM SELECTION

4.1 The timeframes for the selection process of the World Championships Team to contest the 2020 UCI BMX SX World Championships are:

- Sunday, 29 March 2020 (5PM AEST) – Deadline for submission of recorded performances for selection purposes
- Wednesday, 1 April 2020 (5PM AEST) – Final team selections forwarded to Cycling Australia CEO for review
- Friday, 3 April 2020 (5PM AEST) – Final team announced by CA
- Sunday, 5 April 2020 (5PM AEST) – closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, clause 7)
- Monday, 6 April 2020 – Week scheduled for appeal hearings, if required.
