DISCIPLINE SPECIFIC SELECTION CRITERIA

Elite Track Men and Women

2020 UCI Track Cycling World Championships

26 February – 1 March 2020 | Berlin, Germany

1. GENERAL

- 1.1 Athletes will be required to earn Track Cycling World Championship team selection in accordance with clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, and this discipline specific document of the Cycling Australia (CA) selection criteria.
- 1.2 Objectives: See clause 1 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.
- 1.3 **Performance Time Period:** 28 February 2019 to 15 December 2019
- 1.4 **Team size:** Refer to clause 3.3 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.

Track Specific Eligibility

- 1.5 UCI regulations for UCI Track Cycling World Championships qualification will be applied when making selections. These include but are not limited to:
 - 1.5.1 Each rider must have earned the minimum 250 UCI Track Ranking points in **Individual and Madison events** by the end of the last leg of the 2019-2020 World Cup (UCI rule art. 9.2.027)
 - 1.5.2 Riders must have ridden at least one leg of the UCI World Cup in the 2019-2020 UCI season.

2. SELECTION CRITERIA

- 2.1** Consideration for selection to the Track Cycling World Championships Team may be based upon achieving;
- i) Performances in Section 3 of this document, and/ or
 - ii) in accordance with clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, where selectors may use absolute discretion.
- 2.2** Where more athletes meet the criteria than there are places available, selectors may use absolute discretion to rank athletes according to some or all of the factors in clause 2.2 of the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*.

3. PERFORMANCE STANDARDS

- 3.1** The selection panel may consider the performance outcomes and standards indicated below for Elite Men and Women Olympic events; Sprint, Team Sprint and Team Pursuit.

* subject to *Australian Cycling Team Environmental Standardisation Protocol* and recorded under 500m altitude and excluding Moscow velodrome for Sprint Flying 200m.

- 3.2** The selection panel, using absolute discretion, may consider selection to the following Olympic events; Omnium, Madison and Keirin and the following non-Olympic events: Individual Pursuit, Kilometre Time Trial, 500m Time Trial, Points Race and Scratch Race, subject to Australia and the relevant athletes meeting Nation and UCI athlete nomination eligibility.

4. SCHEDULE FOR TRACK CYCLING WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP TEAM SELECTION

4.1 The timeframes for the selection process of the Track Cycling World Championships Team to contest the 2020 Track Cycling World Championships are:

- Sunday, 15 December 2019 (5PM AEST) – Deadline for submission of recorded performances for selection purposes
- Tuesday, 17 December 2019 (5PM AEST) – Final team selections forwarded to Cycling Australia CEO for review
- Friday, 20 December 2019 (5PM AEST) – Final team announced by CA
- Sunday, 22 December 2019 (5PM AEST) – closing date for appeals to be lodged against non-selection (refer to the *Cycling Australia Selection Policy and Appeals Process for UCI World Championships*, clause 7)
- Monday, 14 January 2020– Scheduled week for appeal hearings, if required
