### **Bicycle Mechanic (Casual) Australian Cycling Team**

The Australian Cycling Team is seeking an experienced Bicycle Mechanic. The successful applicant will need to be based in Adelaide, South Australia, and be skilled in servicing Track and Road bicycles. This role is available to commence immediately and will be on an interim casual basis until the end of 2021.

The Bicycle Mechanic is responsible for technical equipment servicing of the Australian Cycling Team's National Track Sprint and Endurance Programs, as well as providing technical advice towards the equipment used by other Australian Cycling Team programs as directed by the Bicycle Workshop Manager, in consultation with the Performance Director, the National Coaches and Performance Support staff.

We are seeking a person with current bicycle mechanic experience, sound technical abilities, strong communication skills and a willingness to support the implementation of actions that support our performance objectives.

Remuneration will be negotiable upon experience of the successful candidate.

#### **Primary Purpose of Role:**

- Work with Australian Cycling Team (ACT) Management, National Coaches and Performance staff to manage and coordinate all aspects of bicycle and technical equipment services
- Assemble, maintain and repair all ACT program bicycle equipment for competition and training purposes
- Working knowledge of major manufacturers' components of specialised cycling equipment, with an emphasis on track sprint and endurance
- Maintain component and equipment records
- Potential for travel to support the ACT Program and/or AusCycling National teams in Australia and overseas
